- II. Announcements
  - Please sign the attendance sheet.
  - From last minutes, PHYS 110 slotted for deletion was referred back to committee by Senate Exec and not announced at last meeting.
  - Student Senate has been active populating committees and, although not finished, has populated Admissions and Retention Committee, Curriculum and Regulations Committee, Student Grievance Committee, Strategic Planning Committee, and University Resources Committee.
    - Student Senator Eric Currier was introduced
    - Student Senator (Graduate) Kyle Malinowski was introduced
  - Subcommittee on Academic Regulations and Degree Requirements has reviewed the Standards and Procedures for Approval of Majors, Minors, and Concentrations as stated in the Guidelines for Curriculum Proposals. The ARDR Committee approved these Standards and Procedures and supports the current version as stated. This was reported to the Curriculum and Regulations Committee which also supported this action.
  - President O'Brien respectfully requests that Senate Committees begin reporting to the Faculty Senate. We are halfway through the Senate/Academic year.

VI. Unfinished Business

a. Motion on the floor regarding changes to the Faculty Handbook language on the charge of the Subcommittee on General Education (pgs. 9-10).

- i. Senator Craig states some faculty have concerns regarding the phrase “*and meaningful*” within the statement “3) To facilitate ongoing and meaningful assessment of general education in collaboration with the appropriate departments or divisions.” Senator Curtis believes removing the phrase increases readability.

1. Senator Craig motions to remove the phrase “and meaningful” from the language in Section 6/a/3 (Subcommittee on General Education)

- ii. Senator Goitein expresses concerns that all Gen. Ed. Steering Sub-Committees have not had ample opportunity to provide input regarding the proposed language, stating that he did not receive the document beforehand and the sub-committees were never charged with reviewing said document.

1. Senate approves Jenny Gruening to address the Senate
2. Ms. Gruening states the document was forwarded to all involved
3. Provost Glassman states Sub-Committee #1 of the Gen. Ed. Initiative has been involved every step of the way
4. Senator Goitein motions to refer back to sub-committee on General Education

*1<sup>st</sup> Bernie Goitein / 2<sup>nd</sup> Amit Sinha – Motion Failed*

5. Senator Schweigert states we need the language in place.
6. Senator Huggins states he believes we should accept the new proposed language and we should now vote on the motion on the floor to accept the new language—with the previous amendment to remove the phrase “and meaningful.”
