## College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) - Advising Checklist

The following list contains specific graduation requirements identified in your UAchieve Audit, including ones that may not be self-explanatory. All requirements need to be completed in order for students to graduate.

120 hours, one major (beginning 22FA)

Minimum 30 Bradley hours for a degree

40 Junior/Senior (Jr/Sr) hours – courses taught at 300-level or higher

30 of the 40 Jr/Sr hours must come from College of LAS courses

Double majors across colleges are required to complete only 24 LAS Jr/Sr hours

Bradley Grade Point Average (GPA)  $\geq$  2.0 for all BU courses

Each major or minor requires minimum 2.0 GPA

Some require higher GPA (see Undergraduate Catalog)

LAS offers two degrees.

Bachelor of Science – 15 hours math/science/computer science/other approved courses

Bachelor of Arts –World Language 201 or higher (see Undergraduate Catalog)

Students who satisfy the requirements for both will choose which degree to receive when they apply for Graduation. Discuss this option with your advisor(s).

All Bradley Core Curriculum (BCC) requirements

10 Areas of Inquiry (AI) plus 2 courses / 2 different AI

No more than two courses from the same AI or the same prefix, excluding COM

2 Writing Intensive courses (WI) and 2 Experiential Learning (EL)

LAS Out of Cluster (OOC) -

First-Year Seminar (LAS 101) OR

One additional BCC course not from the **BCC** division of your major

Computational Sciences (QR), Global Perspectives (GP GS or GP HU), Humanities (HU),

Natural Sciences (NS) and Social and Behavioral Sciences (SB)

Double majors across colleges and LAS double majors with 50+ unique hours are exempt

Other important OPTIONS with their respective requirements:

University Honors Graduation

Cum Laude (3.4-3.59), Magna Cum Laude (3.6-3.79), Summa Cum Laude (3.8-4.0)

Must complete 60 BU hours to be eligible for Latin Honors distinction

Global Scholar – requirements consist of world language, global culture and international perspective courses, study abroad, plus LAS 125 (1-hour seminar) and research

If double majoring, each major must have a minimum 18 hours which do not fulfill requirements of the other major

For double degree, student must complete two majors and an additional 30 hours beyond the requirements of first degree (minimum 150 hours). Not all hours have to come from Bradley
