

The Patricia Campbell Award for Outstanding Service

The Patricia Campbell Award for Outstanding Service was established during the 2014-2015 academic year to recognize and honor the significant contributions of Patricia Campbell, supervisor of administration for the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences. Mrs. Campbell served the College and Bradley University with great dedication and distinction for thirty nine years. In spring 2015, Mrs. Campbell was the first recipient of the award.

The Patricia Campbell Award for Outstanding Service is awarded to recognize university employees whose long-term efforts have had a deeply meaningful impact on the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at Bradley University. The award is designed to recognize the significant, long-term contributions of staff members or other university employees who do not hold full-time faculty status. The award is intended to be a high honor. Therefore, the selection committee, which shall comprise all of the members of the College's Executive Committee, will apply the highest standards when selecting future recipients.

The award will be bestowed on an "as deserved" basis. Consequently, it may or may not be awarded in a particular year. There will be an opportunity to nominate individuals for this award each spring semester. Nominations shall consist of no more than two pages explaining why the nominator believes the nominee is deserving of the award. When a nomination is made the Executive Committee will evaluate the nominee's contributions based on the individual/s length of service and his or her positive impact upon the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences over time. Whether the award is granted to a particular individual will be based on a majority vote of the Executive Committee.
