




Accessing Starting Off (Parents & Guests)

- Canvas/Learn is Bradley University's Learning Management System (LMS) that hosts "Starting Off."





Step #3: You will receive a Welcome message from Canvas/Learn. Click on “**Create My Account.**”




Step #4: Your login is the email address you or your student provided during the registration process. Create a personal password that you will remember and click **“Register”**.
