





The 2018-2019 recruiting year was a strong year for Foster College of Business graduates, with a career outcomes rate exceeding five- and ten-year average rates, and the 2017-2018 outcomes rate. Graduates reported accepting employment offers to work at 123 different organizations. Nine undergraduate majors reached a career outcomes rate of 100%. Organizations employing 2 or more graduates were: Baker Tilly Virchow Krause, LLP, C.H. Robinson, Caterpillar Inc., Deloitte, HNI | HON | Allsteel, Liberty Mutual Insurance, Mounce Automotive, Pekin Insurance, RSM, and Target Corporation.

The 2018-2019 career outcomes rate of 92% for the Slane College of Communications & Fine Arts exceeded both five- and ten-year average rates and was up 7% from the previous year. 22 undergraduate majors reached a career outcomes rate of 100%. Data was gathered from 96% of the undergraduate class and collectively baccalaureate graduates are employed at 112 different organizations. Notable employers include: Blick Art Materials; Chicago Blackhawks; Entercom (formerly CBS Radio); Enterprise Rent-A-Car; Maui Jim, Inc.; S.C. Johnson & Son, Inc.; and The Walt Disney Company.

207 students graduated from the College of Education and Health Sciences. Data was obtained from 197 of them. Of those who responded, 95% (187) are either employed or continuing education. Graduates are employed at 107 different organizations. Of the employed respondents, top employers include: Advocate Christ Medical Center, Barnes Jewish Hospital, Maui Jim Inc., Peoria Public School, OSF, Unity Point, and Walgreen's. Of the 37 graduates continuing their education, 25 are pursuing programs in Dietetics, Medical School, or Physical Therapy. Top schools attending include: Bradley University, Eastern Illinois University, Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, and the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay.

Data was gathered from 99% of the undergraduate class (200 graduates, 197 responded); 88% (179) are employed. Engineering graduates are employed at 109 different organizations in 19 states. Notable employers include Caterpillar Inc. (12), Deere & Company (9), as well as 4 each with CNH Industrial, Graycor, HNI | HON | Allsteel, Honda R&D, Illinois Department of Transportation, Milwaukee Tool, Precision Planting, and Strand Associates, Inc. Graduate School was the destination of choice for 8% (15) of the class -- up from 4% in 2017-18.

Of the 210 LAS graduates, 94% responded to the survey (up 1% from 2017-2018). Graduates continuing their education, 27% (up 1% from 2017-2018), will do so at 34 schools. Notable areas of study include Medical-related (15), Psychology-related (11), Law-related (7), Social Work (5), English (4), Business Related (2), Education Related (2), Mathematics (2), Chemistry related (1), and the Biological Sciences (1). Sixty-five percent of graduates (down 1% from 2017-2018) indicated they are employed. Many of the employed graduates plan to remain in Illinois (72%); while 28% are headed to other locations including 13 states, Puerto Rico, and 2 countries including China and Chile.



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Scope and Methodology

This report includes data about the August 2018, December 2018, and May 2019 Bradley University baccalaureate and graduate degree recipients. The study utilizes data from 96% of all baccalaureate degree recipients and 94% of all advanced degree recipients. Data was collected from students via graduation fair surveys, online surveys, telephone and email solicitations, alumni records, social media research, and input from faculty, staff, and employers. Data collection began in August 2018 and concluded in December 2019.

Career Outcomes and Knowledge Rate

The Bradley University career outcomes rate for the 2018-2019 baccalaureate graduating class is 94%. This is comparable to both our five (93%) and ten year (92%) and 1% higher than our 2017-2018 career outcomes rate of 93%. The career outcomes rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who are employed or continuing their education by the total number of students about whom we have information. We successfully contacted, surveyed, and/or researched 921 of our baccalaureate graduates which resulted in a 96% knowledge rate. The term “knowledge rate” defines the percentage of graduates for whom we have reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates’ post-graduation career activities. Our knowledge rate is considerably higher than the national recommended minimum knowledge rate of 65%.

Experiential Activities and Registered Internships

The Bradley University experiential activities rate for the 2018-2019 baccalaureate graduating class is 97%. This was calculated by tracking students' participation in opportunities such as: internships, co-ops, practica, faculty-led research, capstone projects and study abroad. For experiential learning, registered internships play a significant part. Of the 961 graduates, 24% had a *registered* internship or practicum. Baccalaureate graduates conducted *registered* internships with 181 different employers. The focus on *registered* internships is a strategic initiative of the Smith Career Center. *Reported* internships were also conducted by baccalaureate graduates.

Employers

Baccalaureate degree graduates were employed with 526 different employers in 31 states and 6 countries. The diversity found within this group is a benefit for our students. Employers with a strong recruiting presence on campus include: Auto-Owners Insurance, Caterpillar Inc., COUNTRY Financial, Deere & Company, Enterprise Rent-A-Car Company, Fastenal, HNI | HON | Allsteel, Milwaukee Tool, OSF HealthCare System, Peace Corps, Produce Pro Software, RLI Corporation, State Farm Insurance, Strand Associates, Inc., Target Corporation, U.S. Marine Corps, and WCIC.

Smith Career Center

96% of baccalaureate graduates used the services of the Smith Career Center while attending Bradley University. In 2018-2019 we provided 45 workshops for ALL students and 139 presentations to classes or groups. 3,423 students utilized the services of the Smith Career Center. Smith Career Center staff provided 4,307 one-on-one appointments. We remained a top source of job leads for accepted positions when students utilized resources such as internships, job fairs, and Bradley netWORK.

Standards and Protocols

The terminology, standards, and protocols of the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) are utilized throughout this study. NACE is the preeminent national organization focused on the employment of the college educated. In addition to these standards, the data collection, analysis and reporting of the Smith Career Center First Destination Study was internally audited in 2016.

REGISTERED INTERNSHIPS OF BACCALAUREATE GRADUATES

The Springer Center for Internships administers Bradley’s centralized Cooperative Education and Internship Program and tracks students’ participation in experiential activities, such as internships, co-ops, practica, faculty-led research, capstone projects, and study abroad.

In support of the Bradley University decision to require Experiential Learning for all students, the Smith Career Center and Springer Center for Internships are providing information on **registered** internships as opposed to both **registered** and **reported** internships as provided in the past.

Highlights include:

- 97% (929) of all baccalaureate graduates participated in an experiential activity.
- 24% (229) of all baccalaureate graduates had a registered internship or practicum.
- Baccalaureate graduates registered 368 internships.
- Baccalaureate graduates conducted registered internships with 212 different employers.
