

There were 199 students who earned baccalaureate degrees from the College of Education and Health Sciences. Data were gathered from 183 students who responded to our outreach, producing a 92% Knowledge Rate. We learned 172 (94% Outcome Rate) of responders are employed or continuing their education. Recent undergraduates are employed at 88 different organizations. Some employers include: Advocate Aurora Health, Barnes-Jewish Hospital, Northwestern Medicine, OSF St. Francis, Peoria Public Schools District 150, Peoria Area Convention & Visitors Bureau, The Walt Disney Company, and UnityPoint Health. Of the 39 respondents who are continuing education, some notable schools include: Bradley, DePaul, Florida State, Saint Louis, Chicago, Illinois-Chicago, Wisconsin - Madison and Washington-St.Louis.



Information was obtained from 99% of the undergraduate class (168 graduates, 167 responded); 95% (160) are employed and Graduate School was the destination of choice for 2% (4) of the class - 97% outcome rate. The 97% outcome rate is consistent with national trends and equals the highest rates achieved in the past 10 years. Engineering graduates continued to share salary data (72%) at a far higher rate than the other colleges. Graduates are employed at 113 different organizations in 17 states and one country (South Korea). Employers hiring multiple graduates include Caterpillar Inc. (21 hires); four each with Boeing and Milwaukee Tool; and three each with Aerotek, ARI, Deere & Company, and Manhard Consulting, Ltd.

The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences continued to produce the most baccalaureate graduates (304), and the knowledge rate for these graduates was a strong 96% (5% higher than previous year). More graduates directly entered the workforce this year (67% - up 14% over the past two years), yet LAS continues to send the greatest percentage (24%) of graduates on to graduate school. Some notable graduate school destinations included: Chicago, Northwestern, Penn, Washington-St. Louis, NYU, Purdue, Texas, Indiana and Illinois.



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

New This Year

This report has three significant changes from previous reports.

The Turner School of Entrepreneurship and Innovation is included in this report, and this school had a single graduate in the 2021-2022 class. As there are likely to be a small number of graduates annually, outcome rates may be expected to vary substantially year to year.

The First Destination Study has traditionally reported on the internship and experiential learning history of each graduating class. For several years, the FDS has used a broad definition of experiential learning, here called Experiential Activity, which included but was not limited to registered internships. Beginning with this FDS report, the percentage of students completing a Registered Internship is reported.

Registered internships are approved by representatives of each College, and require students to enroll in a co-op/internship course, which integrates classroom theory with career-related work experience. Many of the graduates in this report matriculated prior to the inclusion of Experiential Learning as a Core Practice of the Bradley University Core Curriculum.

This First Destination Study reports the Career Outcome Rate along with graduates' ethnicity and gender for the first time.

Scope and Methodology

This report includes data about the August 2021, December 2021, and May 2022 Bradley University baccalaureate and graduate degree recipients. The study utilizes data from 95% of all baccalaureate degree recipients and 82% of all advanced degree recipients. Data were collected from students via graduation fair surveys, online surveys, telephone and email solicitations, alumni records, social media research, and input from faculty, staff, and employers. Data collection concluded in December 2022.

Career Outcomes and Knowledge Rate

The Bradley University career outcomes rate for the 2021-2022 baccalaureate graduating class is 91%, which is the same as the previous year (91%) and aligns with the five-year average (91%). The graduating class experienced the COVID-19 Pandemic, which continues to influence outcomes and averages.

The career outcomes rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who are employed or continuing their education by the total number of students about whom we have information. We successfully contacted, surveyed, and/or researched 1,006 of our baccalaureate graduates, which resulted in a 95% knowledge rate. The term "knowledge rate" defines the percentage of graduates for whom we have reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities. Our knowledge rate is considerably higher than the national recommended minimum knowledge rate of 65%.

Registered Internships

The Bradley University registered internship rate for the 2021-2022 baccalaureate graduating class is 25%. Of the 1,064 graduates, 25% (269) had a *registered* internship. Baccalaureate graduates conducted *registered* internships with 226 different employers. The rate of registered internships increased from 19% in 2020-2021 to 25% in 2021-2022.

Employers

Baccalaureate degree graduates were employed with 522 different employers in 33 states and 6 countries. The diversity found within this group is a benefit for our students.

Smith Career Center

92% of baccalaureate graduates used the services of the Smith Career Center while attending Bradley University. In 2021-2022, we provided 33 workshops for ALL students and 112 presentations to classes or groups. 2,823 students utilized the services of the Smith Career Center. Smith Career Center staff provided 4,149 one-on-one appointments. We remained a top source of job leads for accepted positions when students utilized resources such as internships, job fairs, and Bradley netWORK.

Standards and Protocols

The terminology, standards, and protocols of the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) are utilized throughout this study. NACE is the preeminent national organization focused on the employment of the college educated.

The Springer Center for Internships administers Bradley’s centralized Cooperative Education and Internship Program and oversees students’ registration in a co-op/internship course, which includes reflective learning to enhance career-related work experience.

In support of the Bradley University decision to require Experiential Learning for all students, the Smith Career Center and Springer Center for Internships are providing information on **registered** internships. Previously, we provided additional information on reported internships, participation in practica, faculty led research, capstone projects, and study abroad. With the inclusion of the Experiential Learning requirement, this broader classification is less informative as student participation approaches 100%.

Highlights include:

- 25% (269) of all baccalaureate graduates had a **registered** internship.
- Baccalaureate graduates **registered** 428 internships with 226 different employers.
